SHALL THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC MEASURE BE ADOPTED?

Summary: To authorize imposition of a **local sales and services tax** in the City of Deep River, Iowa at the rate of one percent (1%) to be effective from July 1, 2027 until repealed.

A **local sales and services tax** shall be imposed in the City of Deep River, Iowa at the rate of one percent (1%) to be effective from July 1, 2027 until repealed.

Revenues from the sales and services tax shall be allocated as follows:

0% for property tax relief

The specific purposes for which the revenues shall otherwise be expended is:

100%

for funding the support of infrastructurestreets, water, sewer, and the enhancement and maintenance of City services and facilities; and any other lawful purpose of the county as determined annually by the Deep River City Council.
