SHALL THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC MEASURE BE ADOPTED?

Summary: To authorize imposition (renewal) of a local sales and services tax in the City of Malcom that will continue without repeal of the existing local sales and services tax at the rate of one percent (1%) to be effective on July 1, 2027, until repealed.

A local sales and services tax shall be imposed (renewed) in the City of Malcom that will continue without repeal of the existing local sales and services tax at the rate of one percent (1%) to be effective on July 1, 2027, until repealed.

Revenues from the sales and services tax are to be allocated as follows:

0% for property tax relief.

The specific purpose for which the revenues shall otherwise be expended is:

All LOST funding will be equally divided to provide for repair/replacement and continuous maintenance of the streets, water and sewer mains/pipes/peripherals and for the city of Malcom's community center/auditorium, and/or for any other lawful purpose as determined by the City Council of the City of Malcom, Iowa.
